Conservatives candidate for Mid Sussex

Say No to Cuck-Stye

A document has been delivered recently in Cuckfield and Ansty by Fairfax Developers. It shows their plans to develop Ansty Farm to create 1,450 homes on an area of beautiful natural countryside between Ansty and Cuckfield, a development that has become commonly known as Cuck-Stye.

This site has been previously rejected under the District Plan.

A 'Public Consultation' has been arranged by Fairfax at Ansty Village Hall for 20th and 23rd September, commencing at 10am both days.

I absolutely object to this unwanted and unreasonable intrusion into our beautiful landscape which will impinge in a devastating manner on the small villages of both Ansty and Cuckfield, serving to conjoin both homesteads into a single urban conurbation. I have the support of our local Councillors and MP Mims Davies – we are united in our opposition to this unwarranted and unnecessary site.

The scheme has previously been considered by Mid Sussex District Council and has been rejected primarily on transport grounds as the surrounding roads would be totally overwhelmed by the traffic generated by this development. There are many other causes for rejection including impact on an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, infrastructure capacity etc. hence the scheme was omitted from the District Plan.

Rest assured we will be doing our utmost to enforce the District Plan and prevent this totally disproportionate scheme from ever being implemented. I hope I have your support, please do get in touch and let me know your views.
